

Friends of Harmonie State Park Outdoor Education Pavilion



We are excited to introduce the Outdoor Education Pavilion. Plans call for a 30' x 50' structure with a partial brick wall all around. The Tree Cookie will be built into the front wall. It will have electric and water and will be built in the woods directly to the right and behind the Nature Center. It will provide much needed space for larger educational programs than the existing Nature Center can hold as well as many other events put on by FHSP and the campground hosts.

Expected costs are \$43,000. We have raised almost half that from grants from Posey County Community Foundation (\$7,200), Toyota Foundation (\$5,000), Vectren Foundation (\$5,000), Old Beech Cemetery Board (\$4,000) and the West Side Nut Club (\$500). Midwest Roofing and Sheet Metal has agreed to provide materials and labor to help cover some expenses.

To help fund the balance, we are implementing a "Brick" program. For donations of \$100 or more we will put your name or families name on a brick that will go in the sidewalk at the entrance to the OEP.
